Follow this road (SLOWLY) through a farmyard, out the other side to Park Farm. Postcode – WS15 3ER. **Meet at 9.00 a.m. for 9.30 a.m. start. Please note – Whilst this is an Open Test, you can enter if your dog has no awards but please bear in mind that the standard of work may be higher than in a Novice Test. If entries exceed 40, dogs with awards will receive preference in the draw.**

Definitions for Working Tests. J(G)2

Novice Spaniel - Dogs which have NOT won a Novice Working Test, or gained a 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open Test or ANY Field Trial award, incl. COM.
(excluding awards in Puppy Working Tests)

Open. Open to any dog with or without awards although if entries exceed 40, preference in the draw will be given to dog with ANY Test or Trial award.

Young Handlers (17 yrs or under) Young handlers may enter the Test on March 24th where specific awards will be given. They do not have to own the dog and entry is free. All we need is the Handlers Name and the Dog's Pet name. Young handlers entering other Tests will be bound by normal Working Test guidelines. KC Regs. J(G) but entry will be FREE.
