### **Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> March. A/V Spaniel Novice AND Open.**

**Park Farm, Bagots Park, near Abbots Bromley, Staffordshire. WS15 3ER.**

**BOTH Tests will start at 9.30am and will run at the same time. You may enter BOTH Tests if you wish.  
There will be a short walk between the Tests but running in both will not cause problems except you may get  
your run "out of turn" numerically.**

**Judges - Novice. Ian Bogaki B3409 and Martyn Elliott NP.**

**Judges - Open. Alistair Ross A2694 and Paul Johnson NP**

Directions. From the A50, follow the A515 towards Lichfield. Drive through Draycott in the Clay and up the hill. Just past the speed camera, turn first RIGHT towards Marchington. Follow this road, straight, over a crossroads, until you reach a LEFT turn to Hoar Cross. Turn left here and follow this road and turn SECOND right at a Y Junction. The turning for Bagots Park is along this road on the LEFT. Follow Club signs.

From the B5013 Abbots Bromley to Uttoxeter road, just outside Abbots Bromley, turn at the junction with a sign for Freedom Brewery. Follow this road (SLOWLY) through a farmyard, out the other side to Park Farm.

Directions - Leave the A50 at the Melbourne junction and follow the A514 towards Melbourne. After a short distance you will come to a sharp left hand bend at the Crewe and Harpur Public House. Follow the road towards Melbourne and take the SECOND turning right after the Pub and over the river signposted Ingleby. Follow this road without turning off passing the John Thompson Pub on the right until you see DV signs to meeting point on the right.

Young Handlers (17 yrs or under) Young handlers may enter the Test on April 22nd where specific awards will be given. They do not have to own the dog and entry is free. All we need is the Handlers Name and the Dog's Pet name. Young handlers entering other Tests will be bound by normal Working Test guidelines. KC Regs. J(G) but entry will be FREE.

Declaration:
